Wed., Nov. 6th: The 7th grade class will play Bingo at our local facilities for the elderly. Parents, watch your emails for reminders.

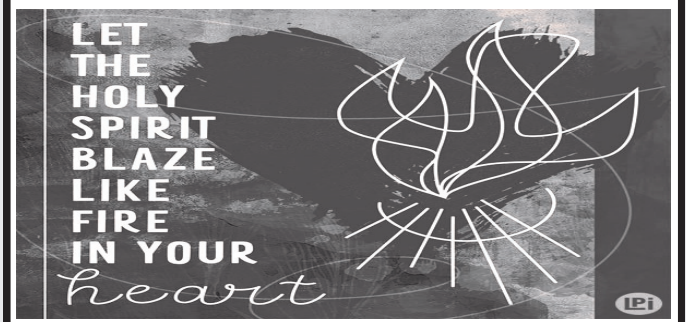
### **FCA (Fellowship of Christian Athletes)**
