### REST STOPS FOR LENT

Life can be busy, hectic and scattered. The season of Lent is a time for us to hit the pause button. It is a time to focus on spirituality in the 40 days leading up to the remembrance of Jesus death and resurrection for us. What we do during this holy time is important for our spiritual growth and development.

**STOP to pray:** Think about how often you pray in any given day. How can you add to your prayer time in a special way this season? Maybe a daily stop at the church or Adoration chapel to pray? What can you do to help yourself pray more frequently even beyond these 40 days?

**STOP to worship:** Attending a weekday Mass in addition to your regular weekend Mass during Lent can increase your spirituality and receive Jesus in the sacrament of the Eucharist.

**STOP to give:** Extra money donated to charity, more time listening to a friend or a lonely neighbor are ways to give and make use of God-given gifts during Lent and beyond.
